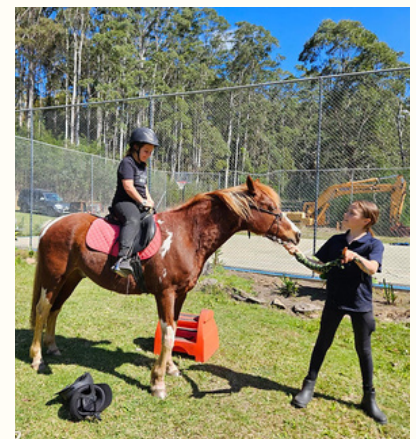
ASSESSMENTS WEEK

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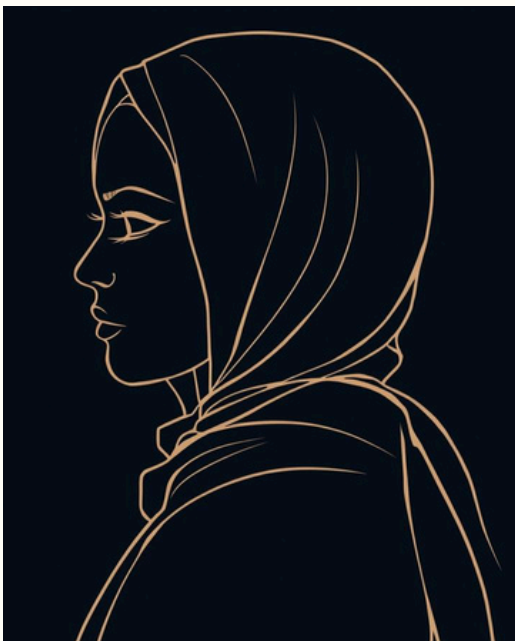
HAPPY TEACHER'S DAY

! IMPORTANT NOTICE TO PARENTS AND CARERS: HEAD LICE AND NITS

We would like to inform you that there have been cases of head lice and nits reported in our school. While this is a common issue among school-aged children, it's important that we all work together to help prevent the spread.

WHAT YOU SHOULD DO:

- Please check your child's hair carefully for lice and nits (eggs) as soon as possible.
- Lice are small, wingless insects that can be difficult to see; their eggs (nits) look like tiny white or brown dots attached to hair shafts.
- If you find lice or nits, treat your child's hair promptly using a suitable treatment available from your pharmacy or by thorough wet-combing.
- Your child does not need to stay home once treatment has begun.
- Please check all family members and repeat the treatment as advised to ensure the lice are completely removed.

TO HELP PREVENT FUTURE OUTBREAKS:

- Encourage children not to share hats, brushes, or hair accessories.
- Keep long hair tied back or braided during school hours.
- Continue to check your child's hair regularly.
